

## Covid-19 Guidelines for Cloverleaf Soccer

### Pre-Game:

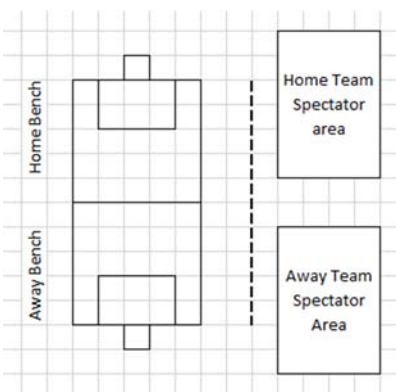
- Players, family members and coaches should conduct a symptom assessment prior to leaving for the game. Players, family members or coaches should not attend the match if they have symptoms of CoVid-19 or are ill and not feeling well.

### Games – Players and Coaches:

- Coaches are required to wear face coverings at all times unless they can adequately social distance themselves from the general sideline crowd.
- Players for U11 and above are required to wear face coverings to and from the parking lot. Players at U10 or below are encouraged to wear face coverings to and from the parking lot.
- Players for U11 and above are required to wear face coverings when on the sidelines.

### Games – Parents and Spectators:

- Parents and spectators are required to wear face coverings at all times unless they can adequately social distance themselves from the general sideline crowd.
- At Cloverleaf Fields, there will be a dotted line along the spectator side of the field. Spectators should sit behind that dotted line. The area is intended to be a spectator free zone where players can retrieve soccer balls that go out of play.
- For games, visiting and home teams should stay separated. Spectators should sit in the same half of the field as their team is located on the opposite side of the field.



- Please limit family spectator size to 4 individuals (2 is encouraged). Note that for away games, local rules on spectator size take precedence over CSA rules. Click here for [link](#).
- Players, parents, and coaches should maintain social distancing whenever possible.

### Suspected/Confirmed Cases:

- We will work with the local health department to identify individuals who were potentially exposed to help facilitate contact tracing.
- CSA will contact OHSTL and work thru any games that may be affected by a quarantined team.
